Benjamin Jones is Associate Professor at the Department of Architecture and Built Environment, University of Nottingham. The focus of Benjamin's work is on measurement and modelling approaches to the indoor environment that can inform policies to create low-carbon and healthy building stocks. He is particularly interested in the energy efficient ventilation of buildings and its relationship with indoor air quality and occupant health. Benjamin supported the pandemic responses of the UK and Chilean governments and worked on ASHRAE Standard 241 that aims to Control Infectious Aerosols in buildings.
